# **R.O.A.R. Horse Show, Festus, MO.**

## June 22-24, 2023

### **Rules and Regulations:**

All horses MUST be inspected by the DQP prior to their class(s). DQP also has the right to inspect horses anywhere on the grounds. Saddles will not be required to be removed, but may be requested by the DQP and owner must comply if asked. Stirrups need to be tied up prior to entering inspection area.

#### THIS SHOW IS INTENDED FOR SOUND HORSES ONLY !!!

1. The Pre-entry deadline is 24 hours prior to each session.

#### 2. DQP fees are as follows:

\$10.00 per horse

3. Office Fee is \$15.00 per horse.

4. Campers, stalls and shavings are assigned and ordered through Reflections Arena. You must go through them to make these reservations. No tie outs allowed. <u>www.reflectionarenaandstables.com</u>

- 5. A WHOA membership is required to show in all classes. Membership fees are as follows:
  - a. Adult Membership \$75.00
  - b. Family Membership \$125.00
  - c. Youth Membership \$25.00
  - d. Show Card Only \$25.00 (covers all 3 days)
- 6. Entry fees are as follows:
  - a. All Classes: \$20.00
  - b. All Show fee of \$250 per horse.

## 7. HELMETS ARE REQURIED FOR RIDERS 11 & UNDER AND RECOMMENDED FOR ALL YOUTH RIDERS. ALL VERSATILITY CLASSES WILL REQUIRE ALL YOUTH TO WEAR A HELMET!!!

8. This show is for SOUND HORSES ONLY! Any lame or sored horses will be disqualified from competition and could be asked to leave the grounds, no questions asked, and forfeit all fees. All

breeds of horses will be checked by the DQP before each class and at least the first place horse will be checked immediately following the classes and Show Management has the right to check any horse as it leaves the ring.

9. There will be no bands, action devices, or plastic wrap allowed at the show grounds! No Exceptions!

**10.** All horses that are showing in all divisions except All Day Pleasure MUST provide a copy of their papers to Show Management at Check-in.

**11. ROAR reserves the right to:** 

a. Cancel, combine, split (where there are 25 or more horses) any class or refuse to accept an entry as deemed necessary.

b. Not give any refunds if any show officials must be substituted.

c. To ask anyone found abusing a horse on the show grounds to leave the grounds.

d. Not to give any refunds to a horse that does not show due to disqualification by the DQP.
12. ROAR will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damage to contestants, spectators, equipment or animals; all exhibitors must sign a release for before being allowed to enter the ring.
13. A COPY OF A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. A COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS IS REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES SHOWING IN ALL DIVISIONS EXCEPT FOR TWH PLEASURE AND ALL DAY PLEASURE.

14. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know and adhere to the breed rules and regulations. There will be rulebooks in the show office for review, if needed. WHOA rules will supersede all breed rules.

15. Lite Shod horses may not wear shoes any larger than 1" x ½". Lite shod horses may show in Classic Park classes as well as Model, Versatility, and other Non-Designated classes. Lite Shod horses cannot show in Trail Pleasure, Country Pleasure, and All Day Pleasure. Horses will be expected to Flatwalk, Running Walk and Canter (Where specified).

16. Trail Pleasure horses may not wear a shoe any larger than 3/8 x 3/4" shoe. Trail Pleasure horses can show in Model, Versatility, and other Non-Designated classes. Trail Pleasure horses may not show in Lite Shod, Classic Park, Country Pleasure and All Day Pleasure Classes. Horses will be expected to Flatwalk, Running Walk, and Canter (where specified)

17. Country Pleasure horses cannot wear anything larger than a factory stamped keg shoe. Country Pleasure horses can show in Model, Versatility, and other Non-Designated Classes. Country Pleasure horses cannot show in Trail Pleasure, All Day Pleasure, Lite Shod, or Classic Park Classes. Horses will be expected to Flatwalk, Running Walk and Canter (Where specified).

18. All Day Pleasure horses can wear a shoe up to 3/8 x <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> shoe. All Day Pleasure horses can show in Model, Versatility, and other Non-Designated Classes. All Day Pleasure horses cannot show in Country Pleasure, Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod and Classic Park Classes. Horses will be expected to Trail Walk, Pleasure Gait, Extended Pleasure Gait and Canter (where specified).

19. Classic Park horses can wear a shoe no larger than 1 ½" x ½". Classic Park horses can show in Model, Versatility and other Non-Specified classes. Classic Park horses cannot show in All Day Pleasure, Country Pleasure, and Trail Pleasure Classes. Horses will be expected to Flatwalk, Running Walk, and Canter (where specified).

20. Novice Horse is a horse that has not won a Blue Ribbon at the International or Celebration.

21. Novice Rider is a rider that has not won a Blue Ribbon at the International or Celebration.

22. To be eligible to show in AOT classes, neither horse nor rider may have had any professional training for the prior 90 days proceeding the show.

23. A Youth is an exhibitor that as of January 1st of the show year has not reached his/her 18th birthday.

24. Communication devices are allowed in classes except: Showmanship, Equitation, and Versatility Classes.

25. WHOA SSH Rules apply.

26. WHOA Racking horse rules apply.
