## ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Entry Fees:** \$20 per class  
Medallion class (no. 47) has no entry fee
- Office Fee:** \$25 per horse (\$15 if pre-entered by Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup>)
- NWHA Fee:** In required classes, exhibitors must be an NWHA member or purchase an NWHA day card at the entry booth. See NWHA rulebook for required classes.
- Stall Fees:** \$30 per stall for day / \$35 if overnight
- Trailer Tie Fee:** \$10 per horse per day
- Shavings:** \$10 per bag
- Camping:** \$30 per night w/ plug-in, \$20 per night w/o plug-in. Pay w/ entry fees. Arrival permitted Friday after 4pm.

- Fees are subject to change. With the new HPA law going into effect, we reserve the right to adjust fees as necessary once the new inspection process becomes available.
- Negative EIA Test within the past 12 months required for all horses. Please provide a copy to the entry booth.
- Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can only participate as a spectator.
- This show is affiliated with NWHA and follows the regulations set forth by NWHA. See the 2025 NWHA rulebook for division and class rules, class definitions, and requirements.
- Classes are open to youth and adult participants, unless noted otherwise.
- Safety helmets are required for all youth competing in speed events.
- Novice horse or rider – has not won 3 blues in mounted rails classes since 01/2022
- Classes designated as “ALL” will call for a pleasure gait and extended pleasure gait.
- Youth Walk Only Class – exhibitor cannot show in any other class.
- Double WWA points will be awarded in all classes.
